

## HIKE, BIKE & RUN

Scoggins Valley Park features an easy to moderate 13.6-mile trail that encircles Henry Hagg Lake. From the trail you have beautiful views of the water and surrounding foothills as you meander through open meadows and wooded lands. Access is provided from many trailheads, allowing for shorter trips or a completion of the entire 13.6-mile loop (11.6 miles on dirt/gravel and 2 miles on pavement).

## HISTORY

Prior to the construction of the dam in 1975, Scoggins Valley was filled with vast farms and country roads. Before settlers arrived, the valley was the seasonal home of the Tualatin Band of Atfalati-Kalapuya tribe. While traversing the trail, glimpses of history can still be seen. Whether you are passing through orchards of fruit trees, riding on abandoned roadbeds, catching glimpses of the remains of former structures or taking in the country side.

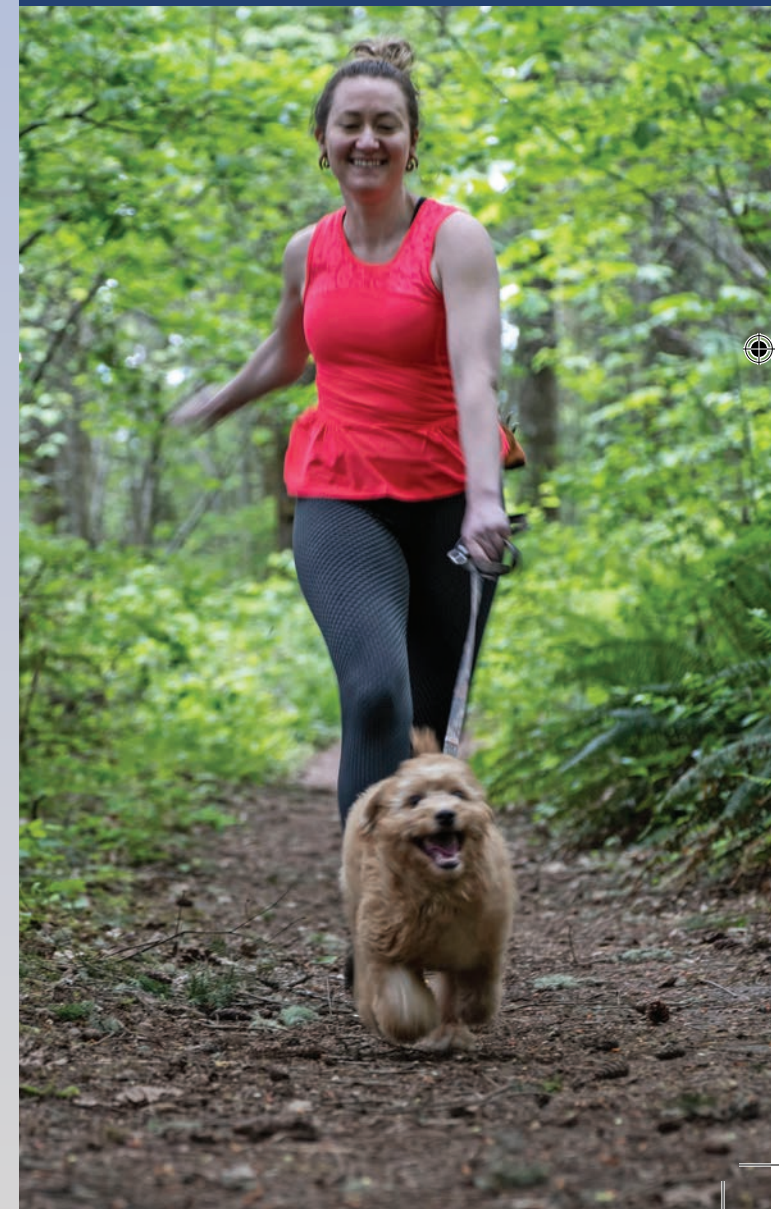

# Henry Hagg Lake

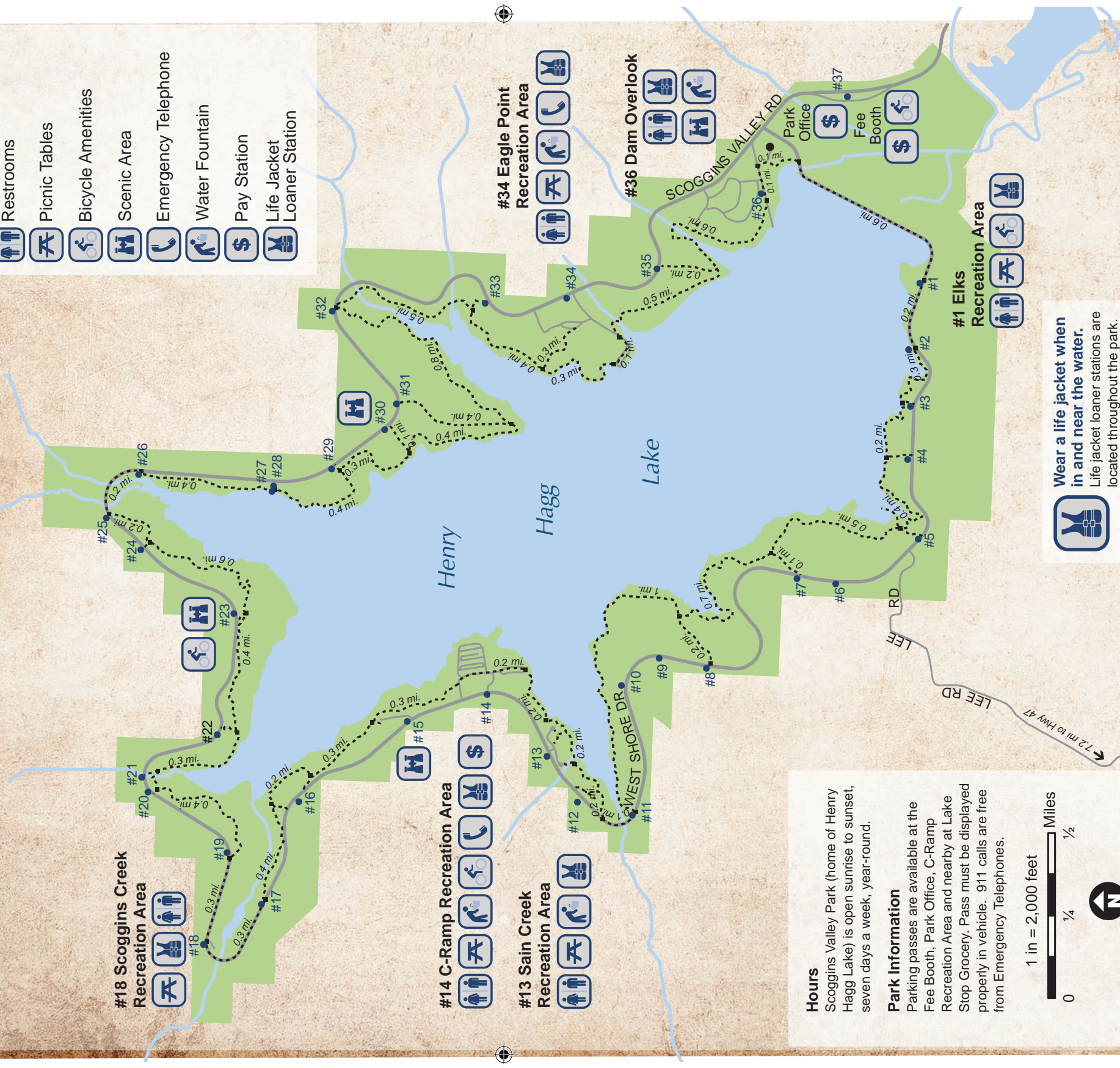


Trail Map
