- Tualatin Basin Joint Project
 - This was the second discussion on this matter following up on the January 2019 introduction to the project by Clean Water Services staff.
 - The U.S. Bureau of Reclamation and Clean Water Services are jointly developing a project to both strengthen or replace the dam and increase the water supply provided by this reservoir. Recreation (including facilities, amenities, programs, and operations and maintenance concerns) will face a unique set of challenges and opportunities in all three options moving forward. This discussion was to identify those challenges and opportunities. There was a lengthy discussion and the highlights are presented in the attached notes provided by Clean Water Services/MIG.
 - Once major outcome of the meeting was the PRAB recommendation that a white paper on Recreation be included as a supplement to the engineer's report. Work on that will be produced by CWS/MIG.
